

Saint Anastasia

„How to become an islander?“



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St. Anastasia Island is a Bulgarian island in the Black Sea. It is located 1.5 km off the coast near Chernomorets, at 12 metres above sea level. The small island near the beautiful seaside city has become a top attraction since it opened for visitors in 2014. The island is located near Sozopol.





The quickest way to go to Saint Anastasia island is to start from the Port of Burgas – passenger terminal that is located near the airport in Burgas. Before that you need to book tickets for a ship. The ship for tourists is called “Anastasia” and has 72 passenger seats. It takes half an hour to get there by a ship. It’s required to go there during summer season.

Once you get there you will be amazed by the breathtaking view. When you get off the ship the first thing you will see are stairs and when you go up them you will come across a narrow path and beautiful nature around it. On the left is the restaurant, called "100 years ago" where you can have a delicious Bulgarian food and seafood. After you have had a tasty meal you can visit the island's lekarna, which is next to the restaurant and in there you can enjoy local healing herbs and nice tea. On the right of the lekarna is the museum in which you can learn about the history of the island and next to it there is a church. It is called "Assumption" and it has amazingly beautiful details on the panels, iconostasis etc.

In the middle of the island there is a stage and there often are made performances to entertain the guests. The island is composed of volcanic rocks and its area is about 9 acres. Climate conditions and sea water have shaped interesting rock formations, named after the form that they look alike – “Dragon”, “Petrified Ship”, “Gate of the Sun” which are located near the other sights.

The people there are warm and kind and that would make it an even better and unforgettable experience for every visitor.
